


KI SAWYER LITTLE TROUT LAKE PARK REVIVAL PROJECT



On 6.26.23, the Marquette County Planning Division submitted a MI DNR Spark Grant application for nearly \$1M to revitalize Little Trout Lake Park in KI Sawyer.

Project goals include establishing a community wellness hub at the Park. The grant would allow the County to invest in safety and security features, ADA accessibility improvements, and park enhancements to create a more enjoyable outdoor gathering space for KI Sawyer residents and visitors.
