Physical

Safe spaces for physical activity; healthy food; health education + chronic disease management; access to health care services

Emotional

Social-emotional learning and mindfulness; Connections to behavioral health services; Trauma informed lens

Intellectual

Education and enrichment; Lifelong learning and experiences

Social

Inclusive and welcoming spaces; Social connections; Connections to community

Environmental

Green space and protected natural habitats; Climate change mitigation and resilience; Connection to the outdoors

Economic

Monitoring and workforce development; Jobs; Connections to social services and resources

Cultural

Community events and celebrations; Visual and performing arts, Cultural relevancy and humility
